## **NSFAS 2024 Applications Opening**

Dear Student/Applicants

Kindly note that the NSFAS Bursary application window for 2024 enrollments will be as follows:

1. **Online Bursary applications opens on Tuesday 21 November 2023**
2. **The College Bursary Offices will be available to assist students to apply.**

To apply from home, please visit the website: [www.nsfas.org.za](http://www.nsfas.org.za) and click on the "myNSFAS" tab.

Documents needed to apply for a NSFAS Bursary:

1. Student ID copy. (Certified – not older than 3 months)
2. Parent or Guardian ID copy. (Certified – not older than 3 months)
3. Spouse ID copy. (Certified – not older than 3 months)
4. Proof of household income. (Pay slip, Employer letter, Proof of Unemployment.)

### **College Bursary Office process:**

- Once a student has completed their NSFAS Bursary application, they need to provide the College Bursary Office with the following information:
  - **Proof of online bursary application.**  
(NSFAS application reference number + [screen grab](#) of application completed window.)
  - **Copy of all supporting documents. (Refer to list above 1-4)**
  - **Copy of the College Offer letter**

**Please submit ALL documents to your Campus Bursary Officer**

### **Important to note:**

**No previous NSFAS applications will be considered. Only NSFAS bursary applications submitted from 21 November 2023 will be considered.**
